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Residential Tenancies (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2021

Portfolio **Associate Housing (Public Housing)**

On 26 January 2021, the Cabinet Business Committee:

- 1 **noted** that in September 2019, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee agreed to establish an infringement regime that would enable the Regulator to issue infringements notices for strict liability offences [SWC-19-MIN-0142];
- 2 **noted** that the Residential Tenancies (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2021 attached under CBC-21-SUB-0010 give effect to the decision referred to above;
- 3 **authorised** the submission to the Executive Council of the Residential Tenancies (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2021 [PCO 23322/4.0];
- 4 **noted** that a waiver of the 28-day rule is sought:
 - 4.1 so that the Regulations can come into force on 11 February 2021;
 - 4.2 on the grounds that the Regulations will have no or little impact of the public;
- 5 **agreed** to a waiver of the 28-day rule so that the Regulations can come into force on 11 February 2021.
